# Present Simple: questions

We form present simple questions with **do** or **does** + **base form of the verb**.

**Do** you **play** tennis? Yes, I **do**. / No, I **don't**.

**Does** he **play** tennis? Yes, he **does**. / No, he **doesn't**.

1) We use **question words (who, what, where, when, how, etc.)** to ask for information. The question words come at the **beginning** of the question. **Where** do you study?

2) **What** is sometimes followed by a **noun**:  
**What sports** do you like?

3) If the question includes a **preposition**, it usually goes at the **end**.
